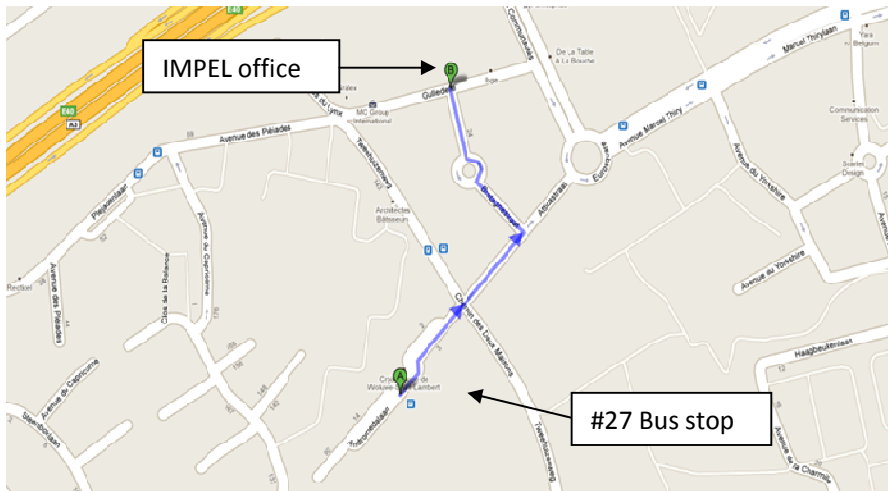


How to get to the IMPEL office

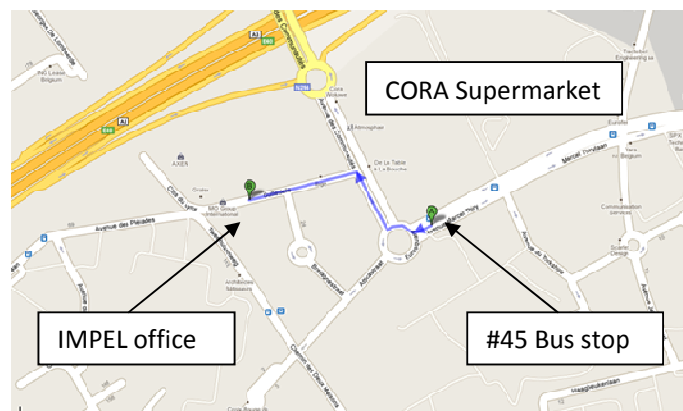
From **Gare de Midi / Zuidstation** there are two options: 1) bus and, 2) metro. For the bus take the number 27. It departs approximately every fifteen minutes and should take 50 minutes in total. It will arrive on Avenue Andromède a short walk from the office. See map opposite.

For the metro take lines 2/6 (direction Simonis-Elisabeth). Alight at Arts-Loi / Kunst-Wet and follow the instructions below. It will take approximately 50 minutes in total.

From **Gare Centrale / Centraal Station**, take Metro line 1 to Stockel. Alight at Roodebeek and then take bus number 45 to Gulledelle. This journey should take approximately 30-45 minutes in total.

From the airport

Taxis are the quickest method of transport to the IMPEL office though buses are available. Take 12(a) (direction Schuman) and alight at Diamant. Walk down Avenue de Roodebeek to Boulevard Auguste Reyers and take bus 79 (direction Kraainem). It arrives at Avenue Andromède. See map 1 above.



By car

If you are travelling by car, parking is available on adjacent streets to the office.
