

# General concepts and recommendations

- Favour uploading images as .jpg
- In the case of logos or representations containing text, it is best to use .png.
- An element or content marked ACTIVE (green button) means that it is visible on the site. If you don't want it to be published, just click on it and the button will turn red.
- Each list has at least one search field to make it easier to find content. The ADD button allows you to create a new element. Existing elements can be edited using the 'Change' button (the 'Delete' permission may initially be disabled in some scenarios and therefore not allow you to delete records; to change this, simply update your profile - in the 'Users' section - and add this permission).
- The order in which the elements in any of the lists are presented is always defined by the PRIORITY field. This value defines the weight assigned to each element and does not need to be sequential. The element with the highest value is the first to appear on the site and the one with the lowest value will be displayed in the last position. These values are assigned automatically when you add the elements. The arrows in the list make it easy to reposition the ordering of elements in the list (just use the 'up' or 'down' arrows).
- The content is automatically translated by clicking on the planet earth icon
- Translated fields are marked with the globe icon
- Changing the language is done in the dropdown in the top right corner



THE CAED PROJECT

As part of its 2016-2020 Strategic Work Programme, the IMPEL Network set up this project in the environmental damage thematic area, concerning the criteria for the determination of the environmental damage and imminent threat of damage, called CAED - Criteria for the Assessment of the Environmental Damage.

The CAED project takes guidance on key terms and definitions of Environmental Damage as a springboard and focuses on the technical/administrative procedures necessary to make determination of environmental damage.

The CAED project has been included in the ELD Multi-Annual Rolling Work Programme (MARWP) 2021-2024 of the EU Commission (as activity 1.3) as one of the activities for capacity building and it has strong links with the European Commission's publication on 25 March 2021, of the Commission Notice C(2021) 1860 final titled "Guidelines providing a common understanding of the term "environmental damage" as defined in Article 2 of Directive 2004/35/EC on environmental liability with regard to the prevention and remedying of environmental damage".

The ultimate goal of the project was to develop a guide and a useful tool proving criteria, methods, decision-making flowcharts, tables and check-lists to help screening, identifying and assessing environmental damage and imminent threat of damage under ELD, as well as conduct trainings on these products.

This Practical Guide proposes a new approach for the assessment of environmental damage based on three phases of ascertainment and on reference parameters relating to "evidence" and to "blue" of environmental damage, taking guidance on the Guidelines SNPA 33/2021 of the National System for Environmental Protection of Italy (see references) as a springboard.

Moreover, with reference to that SNPA Guideline, this Practical Guide proposes a new methodology consisting in using a DPSIR (Driver, Pressure, State, Impact and Response) model adapted to environmental damage assessment and a new tool made of tables of indicators based on the new approach of the ascertainment and the adapted DPSIR methodology. However, this Practical Guide developed a different and broader approach to the one of the SNPA Guideline.

This Practical Guide is therefore connected with a practical tool, namely the Practical Tables, which include check-lists and tables of indicators based on the new approach and methodology and referred to each natural resource protected by ELD.

These Practical Guide and Tables may be used both by ELD experts and non-ELD experts to screen, identify and assess environmental damage and imminent threat of damage under ELD.

In line with activity 1.3 of MARWP 2021-2024, this practical guide and the training activities conducted by the CAED project intend to contribute at improving capacity building of ELD experts and non-ELD experts in the determination of the environmental damage and imminent threat of damage

2.1 About IMPEL Title | Heading 1

One of the aspects of IMPEL that is most appreciated by its members, and by those who deal with it, is its informal character. The IMPEL Statutes reflect that character. Participation in projects and activities is open to environmental practitioners working in an environmental authority that is a member of IMPEL.

2.2 General Assembly Subtitle | Heading 2

The General Assembly is the highest authority of the Association. The General Assembly determines the policy of the Association and decides on the budget, working programmes, project proposals and project reports. IMPEL members in one country designate a National IMPEL Coordinator who represents them in the General Assembly.

2.3 Expert Teams

IMPEL organises its work into five thematic areas:

1. Industry and air
2. Waste and FTS
3. Water and land
4. Nature protection
5. Cross-cutting tools and approaches

The Expert Teams are responsible for developing activities that address key implementation gaps, oversee the delivery of those activities and the quality of their outputs. A Programme Management Group brings together the team leaders of the 5 thematic areas, who then have the responsibility of organising the activities into a single integrated programme.

2.4 Board

The Board is the executive body of the Association and is responsible for day-to-day management and implementation of the General Assembly's decisions. For example, it manages relationships with key external stakeholders such as the European Commission, drafts the budget of the network and manages and allocates funds where needed. The Board supervises the Secretariat.

2.5 Committees

The General Assembly elects an independent Audit and Evaluation Committee, which assesses the technical and budgetary plans and reports of projects and other appropriate activities of the Association. The Committee shall pronounce on the conformity of project and action plans and execution with IMPEL's internal rules and administrative principles.

The General Assembly also elects a Recruitment Committee, which facilitates the filling of honorary posts in the network. Membership in these Committees is open to all IMPEL member experts with professional experience in the respective fields (auditing, financial and project-management, respectively recruitment or networking).

2.6 Secretariat

IMPEL is supported by a secretariat which is the backbone of the IMPEL network. The secretariat staff is made up of a team of five officers.



IFEH's members consist of 58 environmental authorities in 37 countries, the 27 EU member states, North Macedonia, Serbia, Turkey, Iceland, Kosovo, Albania, Switzerland, Norway, United Kingdom and the Ukraine. Within the IFEH Association they can participate in the meetings of the General Assembly with a consultative voice. An Observer can be an international organisation or network which may also refer to IFEH's activities.
